Many Middle Leaders gain their essential skills whilst in the job, although individuals may not have the necessary knowledge and skills they need at the point when they are most crucial.

This programme is delivered in two Levels (aspirant leaders & established leaders), each level is supported by the completion and explanation of successful leadership principles. Support will be on hand via 1:1 mentoring and coaching throughout.

Are you level 1 or level 2?

Level 1 of the programme is about getting our aspirant middle leaders to think about how they are going to lead their (future) teams. The course gives them the tools and motivation to lead adults, to 'sort priorities', 'put forward arguments for change', 'overcome resistance' and hold people to account. Following the programme introduction, and bespoke discussions with the programme lead, Level 1 participants may be able to move to Level 2.

Level 2 of the course is intended for established leaders, leading teachers, TLR post holders and aspirant Assistant Headteachers. The training provides an opportunity to further develop understanding and leadership skills in the context of the management of a specific project or development in school. It will address knowledge of 'self', coaching and mentoring skills, project management and evaluation of impact.
