Katie Crozier has been teaching for over twenty years. She has recently been trained by the NCETM to become a Mastery Specialist Teacher and works with the Cambridge Maths Hub to support schools in developing a teaching for mastery approach in maths. She was also part of the team that wrote the NCETM professional development materials for multiplication and division.

Katie was awarded a distinction for her Masters Degree in Mathematics Education. Her Masters degree developed the use of The Numberlink Board™ to address the need for teaching multiplication with understanding. Pupils using the board have commented on how it helps them to see what is happening and how it helps to link ideas together. Katie says " I've found that children who've struggled to grasp times tables through traditional teaching methods have found that the Numberlink Board™ gives them the structure to build their understanding."
